

REORGANIZATION OF BRANCHES

In order to optimize on the available facilities and resources, parents are informed that our branches are organized as below;

Milai West - Day schoolers from Pre-Primary to G6 - JS (G7- G8) fully boarding - SS (G10) fully boarding	Milai North - Day schoolers from Pre-Primary to G6 - Optional Boarding for G3-G6 - JS (G7-G8) fully boarding
Milai East - Day schoolers from Pre-Primary to G6 - Introduction of JS Day option	

BOARDING RULES

All learners' items should be **clearly labeled** before he/she is allowed into the dormitory. Ensure the learner comes to school with all items listed on the boarding checklist in their right quantities. Boarders are **not allowed to carry any foodstuff** including milk to school. Packed milk shall be served three days a week alongside dinner. All suitcases brought by learners should be returned home for safe keeping after the learner has removed his or her respective items from it.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Effective 2026 the following changes have been introduced; grey trousers in Kindergarten and primary for boys, weekend trousers changed to grey shorts for primary. For JS and SS weekday trousers are beige and weekend - grey trousers. Black long sleeved sweaters for the weekends have also been abolished. All the uniforms are available in school. Parents are advised to ensure that their children have **adequate number (atleast two of each item), right uniform from approved source**. These uniforms include the right: trousers, *shorts, tunic, shirt/ blouse, socks, girls stocking (black), shoes, sports shoe, half sweater, full sweater, fleece, PE uniform, Truck suits, crocks {blue -Kindergarten, Grey –Lower primary, white- Primary, **Black Rubbers- JS & SS**}. All these are mandatory for all our learners.*

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

This service is optional and payable by those who sign up and get approved upon filling the Transport Request Form. Note that on opening day transport services commence in the afternoon, and all parents are expected to drop their learners to school in the morning.

SCHOOL FEES

We appreciate majority of the parents who honored their obligation and paid their school fees in full despite the difficult times. We encourage all our parents to familiarize themselves with the fee policy requirements. Also note that the **2026 FEE STRUCTURE** has been uploaded on our website www.milaischool.sc.ke. Tuition, meals, CBC assessments, excursions, clubs, PTA and activity fees are all covered. The exceptions in the 2026 fee structure are;

- Trips (*see item on academic trips*).
- One off Library Kitty of **Ksh 2000** per learner.
- **Coding, Robotics of 2,500 per learner per term** for those who join the program.
- Parents are also advised to submit the requested list of items in full by the opening day. Those who do not submit during opening day shall be surcharged **Ksh 4,000** since the school will proceed to procure on their behalf to avoid delays in learning.

LEARNERS WORKBOOK

Milai school has embraced the use of personalized learners' workbooks for all learning arears. Parents are informed to purchase for their learners the specified workbooks for all learning areas (**see attached together with list of requirements**). They are found in local bookshops.
