

BOARDING GUIDELINES

Parents ensure your learners' **clearly label** their items using admission numbers (not names). Ensure your child comes to school with all items listed on the boarding checklist in their right quantities. Boarders shall be allowed to make phone calls to their parents/ guardians using the school line on Saturday and Sundays between 4pm to 6pm. Food from outside is not permissible in school premises or the hostels.

POCKET MONEY

Learners shall not be allowed to keep cash in school. Instead the school advises all parents to get their learners ATM cards. In case of any challenges on how to acquire or use, kindly liaise with school management for assistance.
