

SCHOOL FEES

We appreciate parents for honoring your obligation by paying school fees in full despite the difficult times. BOARDING RULES

All learners' items should clearly be labeled before he/she is allowed into the dormitory. Ensure the learner comes to school with all items listed in the boarding checklist in their right quantities. All suitcases brought by learners should be returned home after the learner has removed his or her respective items from it. Food from outside is not permissible in school premises or the hostels. All boys should have evenly shaved hair while girls with braids should maintain black shoulder length braids.

POCKET MONEY

The school has introduced the use of ATM cards and all parents are required to get their learners ATM cards. The cards will be used to facilitate learners' personal expenses, including grooming, tithes and other approved personal effects while in school. Parents should further assist the learners in keeping the PIN for the cards. In case of any challenges in acquiring or using the ATM cards, kindly liaise with the school management for assistance. NB. Parents are discouraged from sending cash to school/ staff for any of the purposes referred above.

ONLINE REMEDIAL LESSONS FOR GRADE 6 & GRADE 9

The school will run ONLINE REMEDIAL LESSONS this August holiday to support our candidates in revision for National Exams. Details on dates, time, subjects and requirements will be shared on the class WhatsApp groups. Let us prepare our learners to finish strong.

CODING AND ROBOTICS

To position Milai Schools as a future-ready institution, the school has introduced the Coding & Robotics Programme across all three campuses beginning Term III, 2026. Parents shall be required to pay **Ksh 2,500 per learner per term** to facilitate their child's participation in the programme.

TRANSPORT

The school has introduced the Express Way Transport Service at Ksh 7,000 per term. This transport option is meant to reduce travel time to 45mins and is restricted to tarmac roads only. Parents are encouraged to register their learners for the transport option to enable the school to plan effectively and consider additional Express Way routes based on demand. Each transport route has a dedicated WhatsApp group for timely communication. Parents are requested to submit their official WhatsApp numbers and complete the transport form (hard or soft copy) one week before the term begins to facilitate proper planning.
